

On World Environment Day, Vedanta Aluminium scales plantation initiatives across Kalahandi-Rayagada-Koraput

Bhubaneswar: Marking World Environment Day, Vedanta Aluminium, India's largest producer of aluminium, has launched a month-long plantation drive across Odisha's Kalahandi, Rayagada and Koraput districts, targeting the
